07/19 Apologies

Apologies were received from Cllr N Adams-King (TVBC) and Councillor RJ Perry (HCC)

Cllr Robson reported that the hedge on Sherfield English Road between Church Lane and the Pound had now been cut.

11/19 Members' Reports

Cllr Bailey reported that TVBC are in the process of purchasing a property in Alma Road, Romsey at the spot roundabout for the entrance to Waitrose, Mole Country Stores and the public carpark.
